“7 Kilometers from Jerusalem”
now shooting its scenes in Syria.



It's the first time that a premium production like "7 kilometers from Jerusalem" chooses Syria as its location, says Mrs Mirjana Tomasic' Scarinci, Syrian line movie producer and owner of Beit Al-Nur.

Produced by Artika Film Production, Rai Cinema and Multimedia San Paolo in co-operation with Syria's Orient Production; "7 km from Jerusalem" is taken from the best-seller book by the Italian writer Pino Farinotti and is directed by Claudio Malaponti. Themed around the shallowness of the Western society and the human need for spirituality, the a part of the movie takes place half on Torino's hills, half here in our desert lands that mostly resemble the holy lands.

Mrs Mirjana played an important role in making this movie possible as she herself suggested Syria as a good location for the movie and managed to get the permission of the Syrian government to shoot the scenes in this area.

Initially reluctant to allow the movie shooting for its contentious title, the Syrian Government eventually approved due to the holy message the movie carried. The message of peace meant to reach all human beings, regardless of their religious beliefs.

The protagonist, Luca Ward, an important name in Italian TV series and the Italian voice of actors like Russel Crowe, Kevin Costner and Hugh Grant decides to head off on a spiritual journey to the holy lands, the lands where Jesus once lived.
